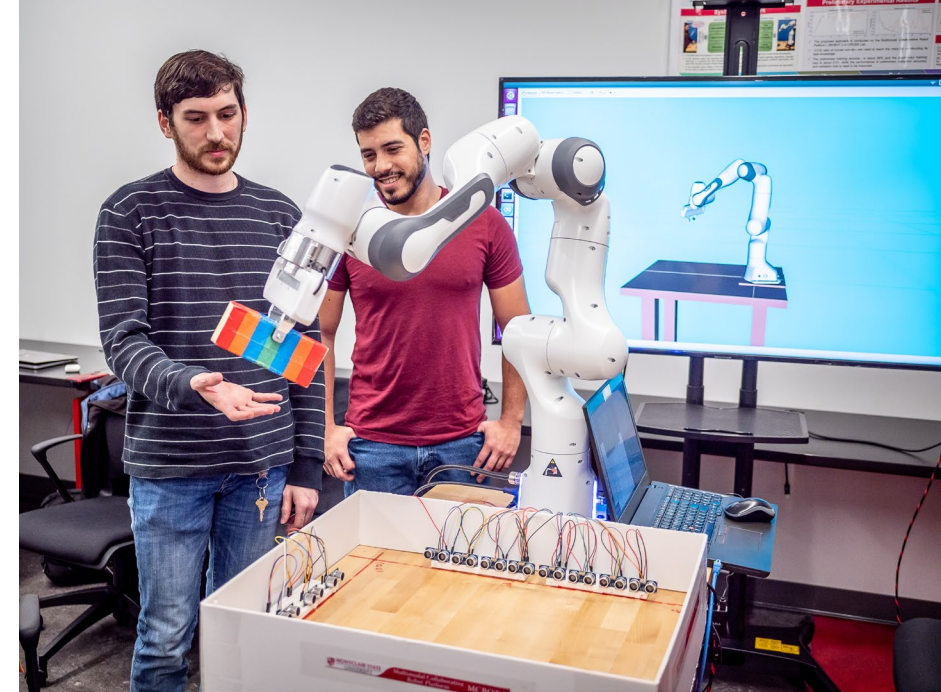

What do I need for a completed application?

FRESHMEN

- Submitted application
- Essay
- Official high school transcript
- Letter(s) of recommendation
- \$65 application fee
- SAT/ACT scores are optional

TRANSFERS

- Submitted online application
- Official college transcripts from every college attended
- \$65 application fee
- Personal statement *
- Official high school transcript*
- Letters of recommendation*

**Only required for select populations*

John J. Cali School of Music, Department of Theatre and Dance, Department of Art and Design and Filmmaking applicants must participate in an audition or portfolio review.



What do I need to be accepted as a Red Hawk?

- Holistic review process ensures you're reviewed as an individual
- Average high school GPA 3.27
- Highly motivated students taking a rigorous high school curriculum
- Involved in co-curricular activities including: Athletics, clubs, community service and part-time work
- College of the Arts BFA and BMus programs require auditions or a portfolio review.

For transfer students, the following programs require a minimum 3.0 GPA:

- Accounting
- Family Science and Human Development
- Biology
- Jurisprudence, Law & Society
- Business Administration
- Molecular Biology
- Computer Science
- Data Sciences

Rolling	March 1, 2021	Two to four weeks after completion of application

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS	Application Deadlines	Notification
Spring Admissions (January start)	November 15, 2020	Two to four weeks after completion of application
Fall Admissions (September start)	April 15, 2021	Two to four weeks after completion of application

How much does it cost to attend?

IN-STATE Tuition and Fees.....	\$13,071
OUT-OF-STATE Tuition and Fees.....	\$21,031
ROOM and BOARD.....	\$16,193

Merit Scholarships

We offer two scholarships for high-achieving incoming freshman students from coast to coast:

1. The Presidential Scholars Program

- Scholars receive **\$20,000** total for four years of study and special academic opportunities
- Student must be a NJ state resident
- Unweighted GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Demonstrate academic rigor

2. The National Student Scholarship

- Offers in-state tuition to out-of-state-students
- Student must be an out-of-state resident
- Unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
