Admissions Process for Athletes

- Student athletes are recruited and must contact a coach to be invited to try out.
- Student athletes must maintain 12 credit hours per semester and 24 credits per year to participate.
- First-year student athletes participate in three hours per week of Power Hours study time at the Athletics Academic Center for Excellence.
- Montclair has dedicated student athlete advisors.

Varsity Facilities

- MSU Soccer Park Home of New York Red Bulls II, this 5,000-seat, FieldTurf facility is lit for night matches and has adjacent locker rooms.
- Panzer Athletic Center Student athlete gym facility with state-of-the-art fitness center, baseball/softball batting cages and basketball court. Panzer's pool for swimming and diving teams is a six-lane 25-yard pool with two 1-meter diving boards and seats 300 spectators.
- Sprague Field 6,000-seat field for football, field hockey and lacrosse.
- Softball Stadium Home of the Red Hawk softball team.
- Yogi Berra Stadium Home of the Red Hawk baseball team
