Energy Technology to Shrink University's Carbon Footprint

Montclair State University will soon take a big step toward reducing the campus' carbon footprint and becoming energy independent when it launches its new, fully integrated, micro-grid power system. Scheduled for completion in late 2017, the state-of-the-art technology will enable the University to go "off the grid" and operate completely independent of local utility companies — a claim that only 17 other higher educational institutions in the United States can make. In New Jersey, Montclair State is the first public university to install a micro-grid system, following Princeton as the second in the state. [View full details]

The Fulbright US Student Program, 2018-2019 Competition is Now Open!

The Fulbright Program is the flagship international educational exchange program sponsored by the U.S. government and is designed to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of other countries.

The Fulbright Program has provided approximately 318,000 participants—chosen for their academic merit and leadership potential — with the opportunity to study, teach and conduct research, exchange ideas and contribute to finding solutions to shared international concerns.

Fulbright Awards

The Fulbright U.S. Student Program Study/Research Award grants scholarships to U.S. graduating seniors, graduate students, young professionals, scientists and artists selected through a national, merit-based competition for study and research abroad. Academic fields include the social sciences, humanities and the sciences. The Program emphasizes leadership development.

The Fulbright English Teaching Assistant (ETA) Program, places U.S. students, primarily new college graduates, as English teaching assistants in schools or universities overseas, where they increase foreign students' English language abilities and knowledge of the United States. They are integrated in the host community, which improves their own foreign language skills and knowledge of the host country. ETAs also pursue individual study/research plans in addition to their teaching responsibilities.
