Montclair State University Max Sobel, Ph.D., was an internationally known and beloved Professor of Mathematics at Montclair University and Montclair College High School for over 36 years, having also served as Chairman of the Department as well as President of the National **Council of Teachers of Mathematics** (NCTM). During his long career as an educator, Dr. Sobel was a visiting professor at Stanford University, University of Colorado, Columbia University and University of Michigan and participated in the creation of what became known as the "New Math" of the 1960's. When reminiscing about Montclair State's illustrious men's basketball history, one name immediately comes to mind, Ollie Gelston. Coach Gelston was the head men's basketball coach from 1967 to 1991. His team captured the Eastern Regional NCAA Tournament in his second season and, in 1981, his squad brought home the NJAC championship title. Coach Gelston ended his coaching career with more than 300 wins, 10 appearances in the NJAC tournament, and

four NCAA playoff appearances. When once asked what he was most proud of, Coach Gelston said it was the fact that 88% of his basketball players had graduated. [View full details]
