Online job-seekers often wonder why they rarely hear anything after applying for positions. Some call it the "black hole" where application after application goes completely unnoticed. While there are many reasons why we might not get the call, one of the main reasons is our resume never makes it to a human reader. Why? 95% of large companies and 50% of mid-sized companies use Applicant Tracking Systems (ATS) to "read" your resume. Check out this great infographic outlining ways to make your resume ATS friendly.


