**APPLICATION:** The application will be sent to all enrolled Graduate students. Students are asked to submit a resume and letter of interest expressing their desired contribution to the Board.

**SELECTION:** Students will be selected based on their level of interest and ability to bring diversity of thought and experience to the Board.
