## Accessing Your File Shares from a Joined Machine

**Please note:** A “joined” computer is a desktop or laptop that allows you to login to the campus Active Directory domain during the startup process. When off campus you must use the “remote access” procedure in the next section.

### Faculty/Staff File Shares and Associated Addresses


Personal (Home) File Share	smb://msufiles/facstaff_vol1/<NetID>

## Mapping to Your Directories


1. Open **Finder**




2. Click on **Go**
3. Click on **Connect to Server**



4. Type in one of the Directory Addresses from above in the **Server Address** field
5. Click **Connect**



6. Type your NetID and password when prompted
7. Click Connect



8. Access your file share through Finder
