

Using Active Directory Services: File Sharing and Printing Overview for Mac

Accessing Your File Shares from an Unjoined Machine

Please note: The following procedure should be used to access your file shares when your joined computer is not on the campus network (ex. home, other remote location) or when you are not using your University supplied computer that has been joined to the Active Directory domain.

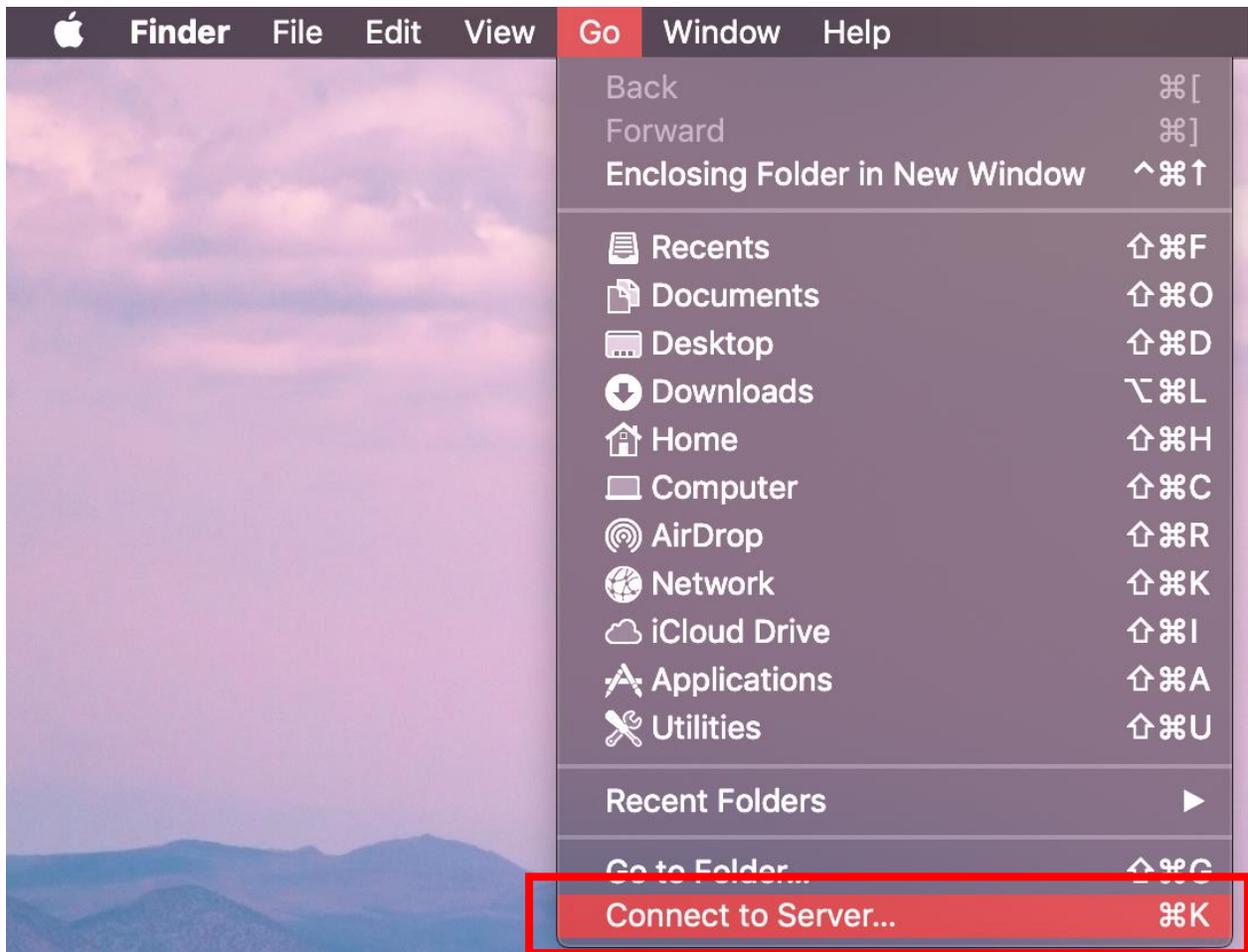

Mapping to Your Directories

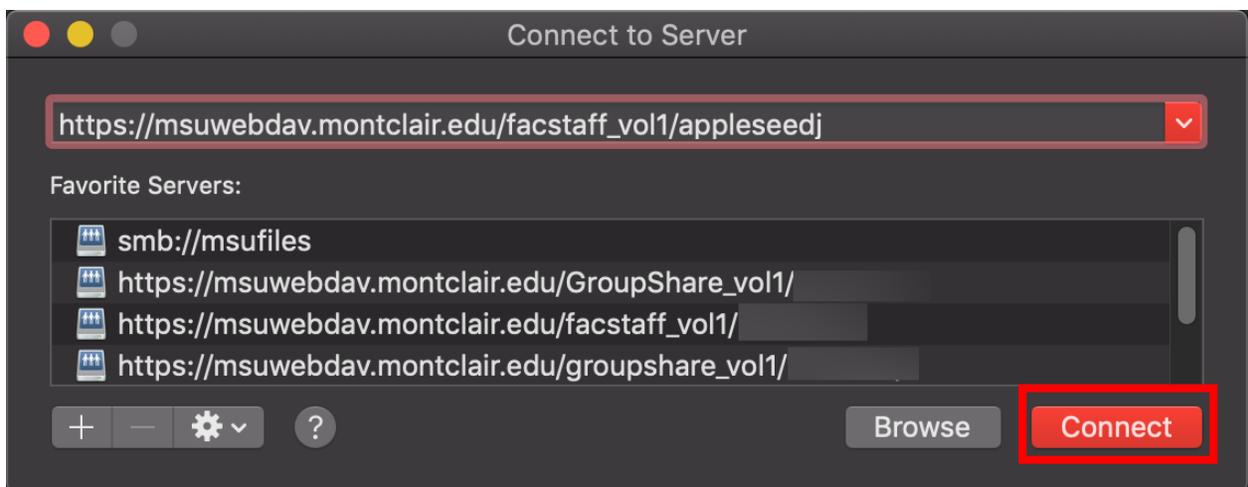
1. Open **Finder**



2. Click on **Go**
3. Click on **Connect to Server**

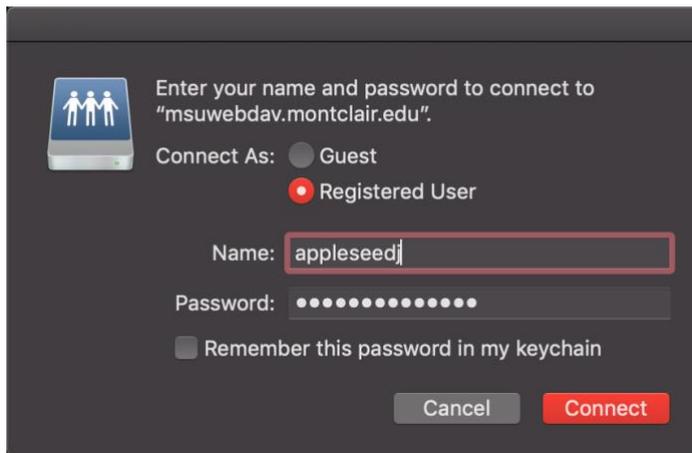


4. Type in one of the Directory Addresses from above in the **Server Address** field
5. Click **Connect**



6. Type your NetID and password when prompted

7. Click Connect



8. Access your file share through Finder
