The Emerging & Instructional Technology (E&IT) Unit originally only offered one-on-one consultation and supported a lab in a small space with three computers and scanners. In May of 2012, the lab moved into space three times larger than its original location and now offers a variety of consultation services, workshops, and seminars. A few recent sessions include: Google: More Than Just Search, How To Create Community in a Hybrid or Online Course, Limesurvey, and iPad: Educational Uses.

SCHOLARSHIP

Focus of Current Research: the formation of working groups in learning environments. Whereas there is good educationally-based research that focuses on the student learning, the efforts to consider instructor decision on the use of work groups has been based on content-specific areas and not learning sciences. I am currently conducting research that considers how, why, and when a sampling of instructors in higher education make use of group work in class, if and how they assigned roles to the members of the group, and what percentage of grade is given to the member of the group and/or the group as a whole. The results will be cross-referenced against career, institutional (Carnegie Classification) and demographic data.
