Curriculum Development:

For several years, I have collaborated with faculty members to revise, streamline and improve existing courses to enhance student learning outcomes. When necessary, I have worked to advance curriculum that keeps up with current with theatrical technologies and practices.

Dividing up **THTR 201 Rehearsal and Performance Practicum** into individual modules in Jan. 2003- 2006. Before this, all students took the same practicum course and it was up to the production officet to figure out which crews and shows the individual students had completed. By dividing up the Rehearsal and Performance Practicum, faculty are able to effectively track students' participation in departmental shows. (THTR200: Production Stagcraft, THTR201: Production Operations, THTR202: Production Costumes, THTR203: Business of Production, THTR 204: Performance Production I, THTR205: Rehearsal and Production: BFA Production and Design, THTR206: Performance Production II, THTR207: Performance Production III)

With the aid of Professor Deb Otte, in 2014 the Stragecraft class was split into specific and individual components to differentiate the Acting, Musical Theatre and Theatre Studies students from the Production Design students who progress at a faster level in technical theatre. THTR150: Stagecraft was changed to **THTR150:** Into to Technical Theatre, effective 2014. Three new courses were developed for the Production Design majors. THTR 151: Stagecraft Production & Design, approved 2009; THTR 152: Basic Lighting & Sound Tech, approved 2009; THTR153: Costume Construction approved 2009. We also added THTR354: Topics in Technical Theatre to address the ever-evolving study of technical theatre.

Converted **THTR100: Introduction to the Theatrical Medium**, to a general education course in the Fine and Performing Arts. This course must meet the strict eleven requirements to adhere to

the guidelines for General Education. As a result, enrollment and course offerings have increased. I also developed the course into an online course for Winter and Summer sessions.

Program Development:

While serving as Chair of the Department of Theatre and Dance, I worked with faculty to develop a new Low Residency M.F.A. in Dance. The program successfully launched in June of 2016, serving an elite professional population. A proposed M.F.A in Theatre Pedagogy has been developed with an anticipated submission in the future.

Under my leadership as Chair of the Department of Theatre and Dance, significant curricular changes were made to the B.A. Theate Studies Program to move closer to the ideal of a liberal arts education, with a more diversified approach. The B.F.A in Theatre/ Production and Design moved away from specific track concentrations to provide a student more latitude flexibility within the program. The B.F.A in Dance changed to provide more dance technology courses. M.A Theatre Studies is developing a new modification to its program offerings to respond to emerging trends in the field.

Artistic Director July 2011 - Present

The Chair assumes the responsibility as the Artistic Director for the Department of Theatre and Dance. The Artistic Director is responsible for conceiving, developing, and implementing the artistic vision and focus of the productions for the department. I also shape major decisions about the ongoing development of the aesthetic values and activities as the chief administrative officer.

BYU is a large institution with incredible facilities and an operating budget of 100's of thousands of dollars. I had just received my B.F.A degree in Acting and was in the process of moving my career over to Technical Theatre. As a result, I felt it was important to work on my new craft and I became the Technical Director/Scene Shop Foreman for the Theatre Department. Utah State compares to the size of Montclair State University as it is currently. I was fortunate enough to teach a few undergraduate courses while I was there, before leaving for graduate school. I was also the Technical Director for over 15 productions there.

B. Other Experience Outside MSU

Brigham Young University is a private, non-profit research university in Provo, Utah, completely owned by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and run under the auspices of its Church Educational System. With a total enrollment of over 33,000 students, it is one of the largest universities in the intermountain west. While as the Technical Director at Brigham Young University (1999-2000), I realized that a major overhaul had to be done to an antiquated system and thought process in regards to production design, especially when it came to keeping up with current industry standers. I worked significantly in expanding the curriculum for students who are interested in the Design and Production program. I worked on developing new courses in theatre construction, drafting, digital drafting, design for education majors, and internships for design majors. I also updated and revamped many of the undergraduate courses in theatre construction making them relevant to the production we were producing. The graduate program was in decline and it was my desire to change the process of operation to make it more attractive to LDS students who got their undergraduate degrees from other universities.

Utah State University is a public doctorate-granting university in Logan, Utah, with over 28,000 students. I worked as the Technical Director for the Department of Theatre (1991-1993) between my undergraduate and graduate studies. While there, I was able to refashion the way the design process migrated to the scene shop and the construction methods used for productions. Many of the processes used were out of date and needed to move up to the then industry standards. The scene shop had been run in an outdated method for many years and this was a great opportunity to move the department into a new direction.

C. Educational Philosophy

I believe that the classroom should provide the type of environment conducive to a broad spectrum of learning, student participation, multimedia presentations and hands on training. When I teach Technical Theatre Courses, I strive to create a clear presentation of relevant subject matter supplies the student with pertinent information needed for a future career in the performing arts. I want to create a common vocabulary between technician and performer so that the artistic process can become less cumbersome and more enjoyable. For example, an actor with proper technical experience will be able to effectively communicate ideas illumination to a lighting designer.

The responsibilities that come with this focus on teaching effectiveness can be challenging and exciting. By showing my energetic enthusiasm for theatrical literature, pedagogy, and history in the classroom, I can compel the students to listen and learn. Not only am I sharing a wide range of information with the students that will help them in the future, but I am also giving them skills that they put to work immediately in the lab hours they are required to fulfill. These skills include many aspects of technical theatre such as scenery construction, scenic painting, prop management, structural analysis, electrical wiring, electronics, shop management, rigging, safety, sound equipment setup and tool maintenance.

Effectively using multimedia to enhance my lectures has had many positive effects on the advancement of my students' understanding of technical theatre. I have used video, audio equipment, state of the art theatrical machinery, show control equipment, intelligent lighting, state of the art lighting consoles, pertinent computer programs and the web to strengthen the concepts that I teach in class. Students then can take these life resource tools and use them sensibly in their homework, production duties, class assignments and future careers.
