

Subject: Recommendation on Selection of the Grand Marshal for Commencement Ceremonies

Date: Approved by the University Senate - May 15, 2019

University Senate Recommends that the Grand Marshal for Commencement ceremonies be selected according to a transparent process with clearly delineated criteria.

Specifically, the Senate Recommends that the Grand Marshal for Commencement ceremonies be determined by the following process:

- 1. The most senior member of the Faculty (according to date of hire) is offered the Position.
- 2. If the most senior member of the Faculty declines, the Position is then offered to the next most senior member of the Faculty, and so on, in order of seniority.
- 3. In the case that two or more members of the Faculty have equal seniority, those Faculty members are listed in a random order, and offered the Position, on, a rotating basis, in that order.
